









Seesaw for Parents

Accessing your child's work

1	All your child's work will appear in their journal	
2	<p>To access your child's work assigned to the this week click on activities</p> <p>Here you should see your child's timetable for the week and the activities they have been assigned for the week</p>	
3	<p>Choose the day's activities.</p> <p>If you click on the picture this will load as an original version of the document where you can just look at the activities assigned to your child and if you click on the hyperlinks to take you directly to websites assigned to the children.</p> <p>If you click on the add response it will take you to a document where you can work directly on the task from your computer. Note: the hyperlinks to website will not work in this format.</p>	
4	<p>Scroll down the pages to carry out each activity.</p> <p>Use the editing tools to write straight onto the page or do the work in your book and upload your work to seesaw (instructions to upload are number 8).</p>	
5	<p>Once all your work is complete click on the green tick to save your work to your journal.</p> <p>Your work will no longer appear in activities but has moved to your journal.</p>	

6	<p>If you have not finished your working on all your activities but have saved your work you can still edit it in your journal (it will no longer appear in your activity box)</p> <p>If you want to continue working on your work find the work in your journal and click on the 3 dots.</p>	
7	<p>Click on edit item and continue working on your tasks.</p>	
8	<p>If you want to upload any work you have done in your book or practical activities click on the green + button</p>	
9	<p>Click on the photo or video you want to take.</p> <p>Take a picture of your work and save in the same way as step 5</p> <p>Your work will appear in you journal.</p>
