## Linchfield Learners

This term's topic in Preschool is The Very Hungry Caterpillar. The children have created their own caterpillars and used their name cards to write their name in the body. They have worked on a collaborative art piece making a colourful butterfly, and enjoyed completing rhyming word puzzles.



In Reception, we have been finding out all about creatures Under the Sea. We have listened to stories such as The Rainbow Fish, Sharing a Shell and Don't Worry Little Crab. We have been looking at underwater habitats and finding out where different creatures live. In maths we have been focusing on numbers beyond 10. We have been learning that all teen numbers have 1 ten and then using numicon to make the different numbers.



Year 1 have been busy engaging with their learning this week. Our art lessons currently focus on sculpture. We have looked at the work of Antony Gormley and used clay to create our own figure that stands. We have engaged in a variety of maths activities involving money, this includes recognising coins and notes. As part of our work on non-chronological reports, we have created our own booklets related to our topic title, 'Every day is a new adventure'.
