Free School Meal Vouchers

The government has announced a further extension to the COVID grant support for vulnerable families to support them over the summer holiday.

All Free School Meal families will receive a £75 Tesco voucher per eligible free school meal pupil of school age to support with meals during the summer holiday.



Drop Off & Collection Times

A number of staff and parents are concerned about the safety of our children at drop off and collection times at school. If you are unable to walk to school please be mindful of where you park or stop when dropping off and collecting your child/ren. Some parents are driving into the outer car park too fast and are not allowing children to cross the car park safely. Some parents are parking inappropriately on the road outside school which is resulting in the road being blocked. Offensive language or abusive behaviour is not necessary or acceptable and could result in a ban from school property. Our children's safety is paramount and should always be a priority for the entire school community.

Your child's annual flu vaccination

This vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of flu.

Please click on the following link to complete the online consent form for your child(ren): Immunisation Consent (lincolnshireimmunisations.co.uk) Please complete at your earliest convenience as the online system for your school will be closed prior to our visit to allow for essential administration to take place.

You will need to enter the following code to ensure the completed form can be correctly allocated to your child's school: **EE120499**

The date allocated to your school will be finalised and communicated to you at a later date. All schools will be visited on two occasions prior to the end of term in December. Should we not be able to vaccinate your child(ren) in school alternative arrangements will be made and communicated to you.

The vaccination is free and is a quick and simple spray up the nose. This vaccine is a yearly vaccine. All vaccinated children will be given a sticker.
