#### Dear Families

This week has been very different week in school and we have missed having all of our children in to start the new term together. I hope those children that have been working from home on Seesaw have been able to access and enjoy the home learning that was provided. I know the teachers really enjoyed seeing all the hard work the children produced and were very impressed by what they had submitted from families. Thank you all for working so hard on this – I know from my own experiences of having 4 children at home during lockdown this is no easy task.

This week, following late government guidelines issued late on Wednesday, we had to make the very difficult decision to further close more bubble in school but tried to work quickly to resolve all our staffing issues so that we are now ready and excited to welcome back all our children to school on Monday. If, however during me writing this newsletter and Monday morning anyone has a positive Covid test, year group bubbles will have to close and home learning will be provided.

We have now reassessed out risk assessment (which is attached) and, in consultation with the Trust, have taken the decision to move from class bubbles to year group bubbles, still keeping in line with government guidelines. Taking this into account we have revised our break and lunchtimes so children in each year group can play together (please see information below). We have not changed the arrangements to our morning and end of the day routines.

This week we have had a lot of parent feedback about decisions we have had to make in school at very short notice. We always appreciate all the feedback that comes from parents and try to act on this to continue to drive our school forwards. It is never our intention to keep parents in the dark about decisions that affect your children and we will continue to work with you on our communication.
