Attendance

Good attendance is vital for your child's learning and development. Following statutory guidelines, absences cannot be authorised during term time and may only be granted in the most exceptional circumstances. Please ensure that children come to school promptly every day so that they don't miss out on vital learning time.

95% attendance is the minimum target for all children. Every day counts!

The chart below shows the impact of missed days on children's learning.

missed

In school for the full 190 days 100% attendance 190 days Best chance of success-gets your child off to a flying start each year In school 180 days,10 days of learning missed 95% attendance This is the minimum target for all children. 10 days missed 19 days missed In school for 161 days, 29 days of learning missed 85% attendance This is worrying as almost 6 weeks of school missed in 29 days one year making it harder for your child to make progress. School Liaison Officer is involved. missed In school for 152 days, 38 days of learning missed 80% attendance 38 days

This is a serious concern-not fair on your child! We work closely with the family and the School Liaison Officer to help overcome difficulties.

Safeguarding

Safeguarding is the action that is taken to promote the welfare of children and to protect them from harm. This involves protecting children from abuse and maltreatment, preventing harm to children's health or development and ensuring children grow up with the provision of safe and effective care.
